

# Winter Programme 2019 - 20

## Nursery & P1

For a one-hour session, all three topics can be delivered. For a slightly shorter session, two topics can be chosen.  
All activities will be tailored to the level of the class.

Topics	
<b>Pollinators</b>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Which animals need flowers for food?</b></p> <p>Children will learn about animals that need flowers to survive and why they are important. An energetic game will show that pollinators do not all feed from the same flowers and that lots of different flowers are needed to support all these animals.</p>
<b>Trees</b>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>How do seeds turn into trees? What do trees need to survive?</b></p> <p>This topic will carry the message of how important trees are for the planet. A short activity will show the children some common seeds and what trees they turn into. They will also learn through a game, what seeds need in order to germinate and turn into trees.</p> <p>Each child will be given a seed from a native tree to plant in a pot and look after. If the tree grows well it can be planted in the school grounds or at home.</p>
<b>Ocean</b>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>What animals live in the ocean? How are they adapted to living in water?</b></p> <p>Through mini puzzles, a rock hunt and clay animal moulding, children will discover what animals live in our oceans and how they survive underwater. From these activities they will gain an understanding of the importance of these marine animals and why we need to protect our oceans.</p>
